National Societies Committee members have a particular interest in the advancement of GI related matters in all countries of Europe and the Mediterranean Area, and in ensuring that the voice of National Societies is represented across all UEG initiatives and structures.

The UEG National Societies Committee (NSC) has developed a specific job description including essential criteria for candidates in terms of skills and experience.

Please note that only candidates supported by a UEG National Member Society can be considered.

Mandatory documents for nomination:

- Mission statement (max. 200 words)
- One page A4 Curriculum Vitae
- Supporting letter from a [UEG National Member Society](#)

Deadline for nominations: September 22, 2017.

Nominations must be submitted via the online form provided at <http://www.ueg.eu/about-ueg/open-calls/>.

Nominations received via e-mail, fax or regular mail cannot be accepted.

Elections will be held during the UEG National Societies Forum (NSF), Sunday, October 29, 2017 on occasion of UEG Week 2017 at Fira Gran Via, Barcelona, Spain.

The candidates must agree to their nomination and the voting will be by ballot based on a weighted voting system. Personal attendance of each candidate is mandatory.
